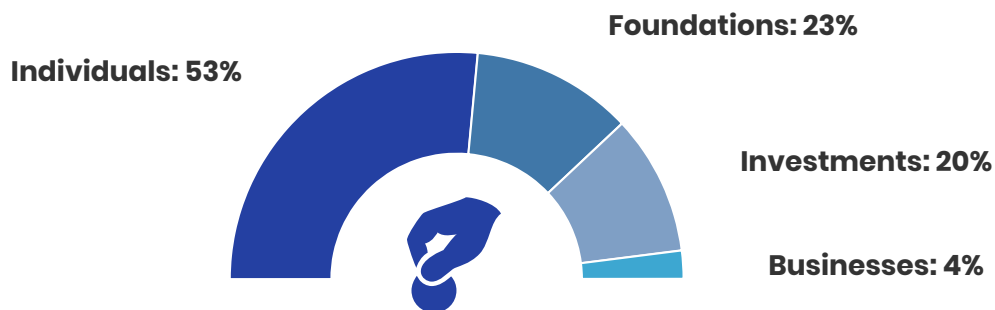

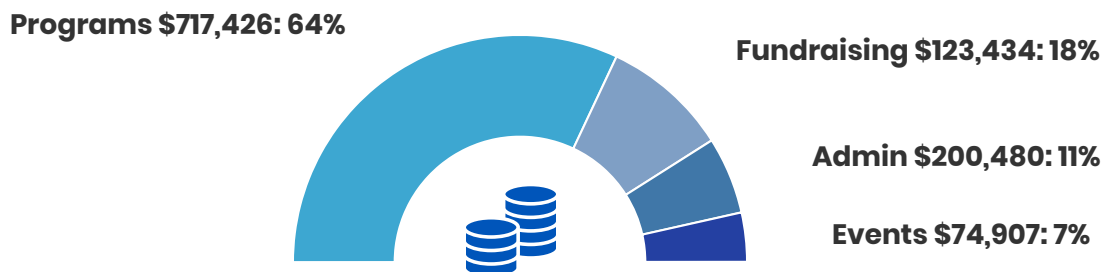
NET ASSETS 3/31/18 \$3,510,537
